Teach Through Case Studies

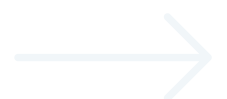
- Teach writing craft and grammar through engaging case studies
- Let students see how different authors uniquely demonstrate language concepts
- Explore author inspirations by reading about their lives or watching interviews
- Prompt students to reflect on their own inspirations and ways of expressing themselves





Use Guiding Questions

- Makes language skills explicit
- Keeps the objective and end in mind clear
- Supports progression from surface to conceptual learning
- Helped scaffold student thinking





Time to Learn Time to Apply

- Provide structured, regular, and ample time to apply
- Ensure students apply new skills shortly after learning them
- Help students transfer learning to both familiar and unfamiliar contexts
